

Prof. Dr. Christian Gernhardt, DMD, PhD

Prof. Dr. Gernhardt is assistant medical director and associate professor in the Department of Operative Dentistry and Periodontology at the Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg, Germany. Prior to joining Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg in 1999, he was a senior faculty member (1999) and assistant professor (1997-99) in the Department of Prosthodontics at the Albert-Ludwigs-University of Freiburg. Prof. Dr. Gernhardt started his dental education in 1992 at the University of Ulm, Germany. After leaving Ulm he graduated and earned his Doctorate from the University of Freiburg in 1997, and completed his postdoctoral thesis and received the Venia legendi in Operative Dentistry and Periodontology in 2009 at the Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg. His research findings have been presented in numerous publications and in national and international presentations. Prof. Dr. Gernhardt is also specialist in Endodontics of the German Society of Endodontics. Prof. Dr. Gernhardt's main focus within clinical practice and research is adhesive and esthetic dentistry, dentin hypersensitivity, cariology and endodontics, with an emphasis on restorative and preventive dentistry and dental materials. Prof. Dr. Gernhardt is also a member of the editorial boards for the Quintessence International, the Journal of Applied Oral Sciences and serves as a scientific reviewer for a number of other scientific dental journals. He is an active member of many professional societies, including the International Association for Dental Research (IADR), the Continental European Division (CED), the German Society of Operative Dentistry (DGZ), the German Society of Endodontics (DGET). Since 2013 Prof. Dr. Gernhardt is president of the German Society of Endodontics (DGET). Since 2012 he is president of the Society for Dentistry and Oral Medicine at the Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg. Prof. Dr. Gernhardt is the recipient of multiple teaching as well as research awards and has published and lectured extensively on various topics of cariology, esthetic dentistry, restorative dentistry, endodontology, periodontics, implantology, and dental materials.
